

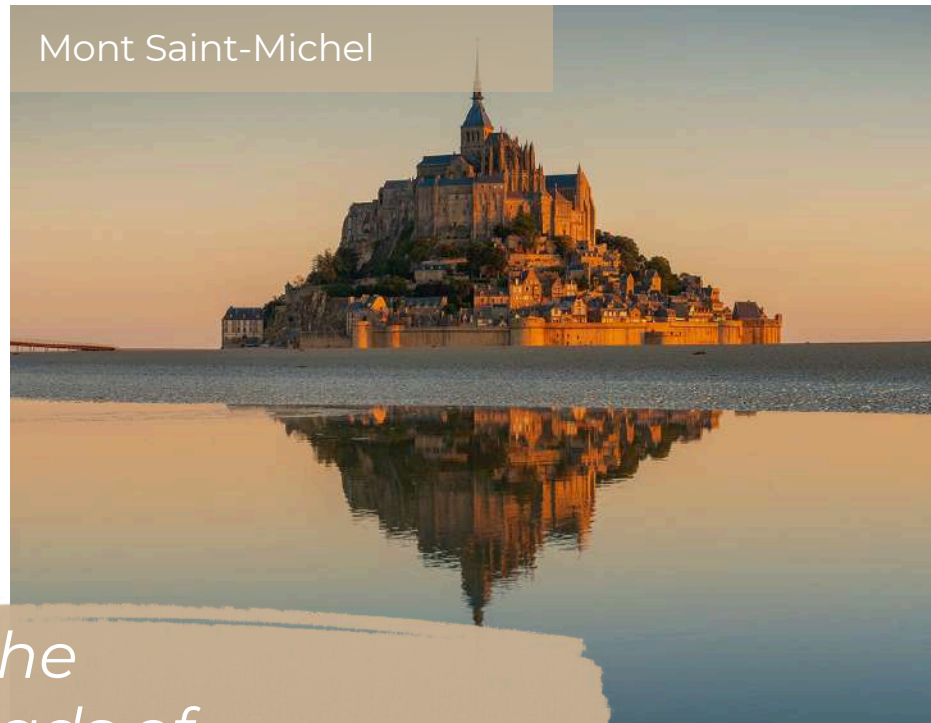

## TECHNICAL

- Quai en Seine #3 (**max. length 260 m / max. draught 9 m**)
- Quai en Seine #1 (**max. length 180 m / max. draught 9 m**)
- Port accessible 24/7, all year running
- Transit and Turnaround
- Fully compliant with the ISPS Code
- Fares are public and degressive
- Fast maneuver (2h from pilote station)
- Tidal harbour
- Linesmen
- Tug services

## SERVICES *(through your port agent)*

- Bunkering (by trucks)
- **Shipshandler services 24/7**
- **Water supplies (max. 50 cbm/h)**
- Garbage disposal
- Passenger boarding bridge

## HIGH-END AND LUXURY WELCOME

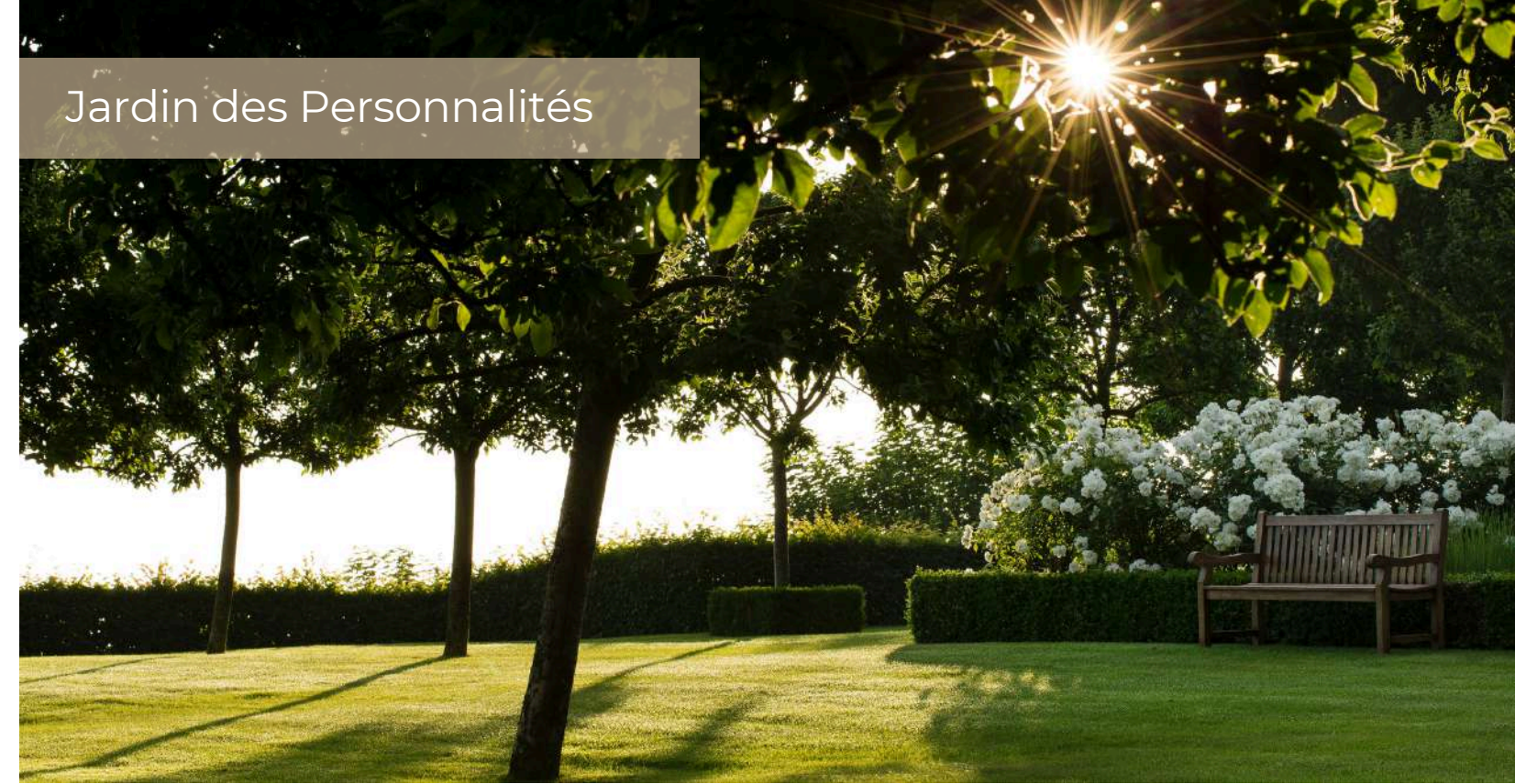
For a unique and charming welcome, horse-drawn carriages can meet passengers directly at the terminal for a scenic tour through Honfleur's old town.

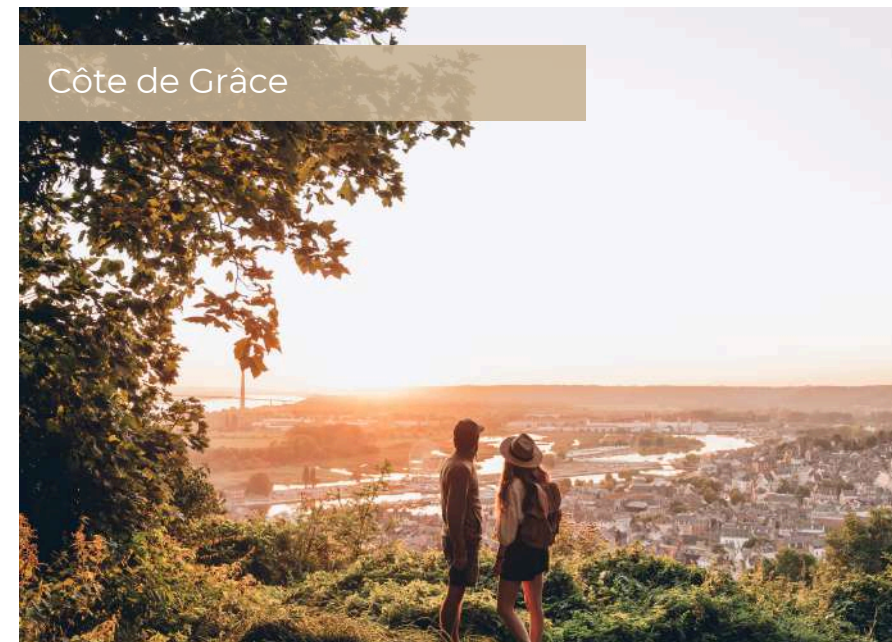

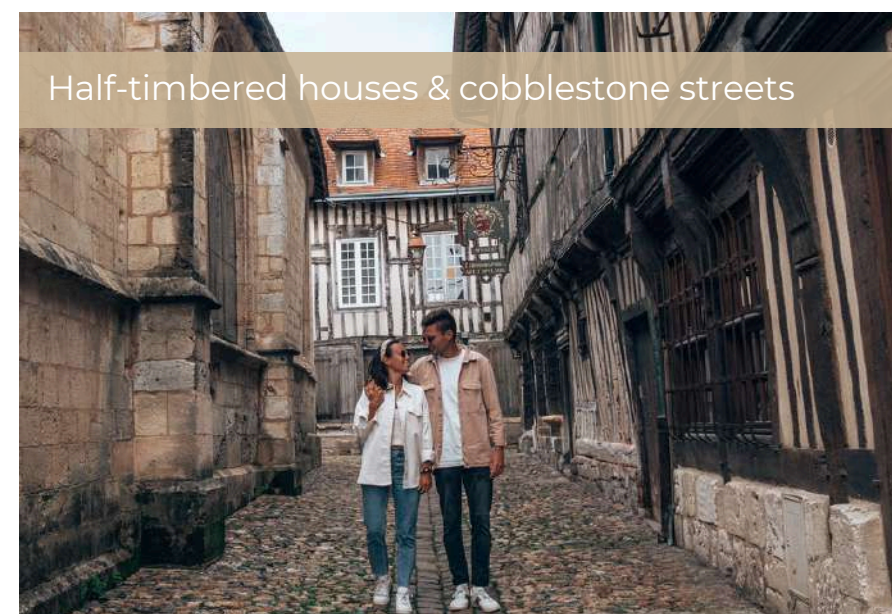
